Grosvenor estimated that suppliers to our property business would account for over 50% of emissions between 2019-2030. Working with partners committed to net-zero has therefore been identified as a critical success factor in meeting our own commitment of reducing emissions by 90% by 2040 as verified by the SBTi.

Recognising the importance of supply chain emissions was one of the key drivers in creating the emissions reduction mentorship programme. The programme was designed in partnership with Heart of the City, and largely delivered by them. It focused on providing support to SME suppliers (with less than 500 employees) across workshops, clinic sessions, and 1:1 mentoring in calculating their baseline, setting an action plan and submitting for a validated science-based target and reducing their carbon footprint over an eight-month period. The SMEs were placed in a cohort, learning together with their peers as well as learning from the experts.
